The Issue- Silos in Teams:

In our work with corporate teams, we often run into situations where leaders tell us that rather than working as a unified team, their organization operates in silos. In other words, smaller teams (or factions) form that not only do not work well together, but can often work at cross-purposes to each other. Of course, this can increase tension and frustration with a resulting reduction of morale and productivity.

Our Sixth Sense:

So what's really going on under the surface? Well, there can be a number of reasons for the formation of silos. One reason is that the team forms without a unifying objective or purpose to unite around. This seems like an obvious element of a team, but can be missed in the haste of forming the team and starting the work.

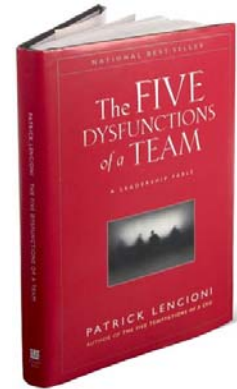
Sixsense Launches New Team Building Events Division
